**SCRIPTURE FOCUS:** Today Jesus predicts his suffering, rejection and resurrection for the third time. The pattern is always the same: Jesus predicts his suffering; the disciples fail to understand; Jesus then teaches clearly about himself and about what following him means. In his third prediction of suffering, Jesus describes how he will be handed over to his own people's religious leaders and to the Gentiles and will be spit upon and mocked. James and John, Jesus' inner circle of followers, get caught on the glory promised. They argue for first place. But Jesus points out to them that true greatness is serving the real needs of others - not what the masses of people or the ones in power want. Jesus is that obedient servant of God.

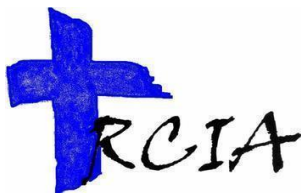
